LSAANZ 2019 Conference

Southern Cross University School of Law and Justice is proud to convene and organise, together with the Law, Literature and the Humanities Association of Australasia (LLHAA) and the Law and Society Association of Australia and New Zealand (LSAANZ), the 2019 LLHAA conference and the 2019 LSAANZ conference, respectively titled *JurisApocalypse Now! Law in End Times*, and *Survive. Thrive. Die. Law in End Times*.

The two conferences, although distinct and separate, are nonetheless connected by a shared overarching theme, and are articulated around a shared Postgraduate Day. LSAANZ is offering travel bursaries to assist higher degree research students to attend its conference and postgraduate day (5-7 December 2019).

Criteria and Quantum

Qualifying students must be currently enrolled in a higher degree research qualification (e.g. PhD or Masters) in Australia or New Zealand and must attend the post-graduate day and the conference, presenting a paper at the conference. Students must be unable to access funding from their home institution to support their attendance at LSAANZ.

A maximum of up to three bursaries will be awarded for reimbursement of travel costs: up to \$AUD400 will be awarded to Australian-based students and up to \$AUD850 will be awarded to New Zealand-based postgraduate students. Scholarship recipients must attend the conference and present a paper to receive reimbursement of travel costs and withdrawal or non-attendance will automatically forfeit entitlement to the scholarship. Successful recipients will still be required to pay the conference registration fee (\$AUD140+GST).

Higher Degree Research students from Arts and Social Sciences are particularly encouraged to apply.

Application Process

Please respond to the conference <u>call for abstracts by 31 August 2019</u>. You must present at the conference to apply for a bursary.

- explain how attendance at the conference will assist your study
- explain why you cannot access funds to support your attendance from your institution
- state your degree programme and institution
- estimate your travel and accommodation costs
- attach your submitted conference abstract.
- provide contact details for your supervisor. LSAANZ will contact your supervisor to verify your eligibility before awarding a bursary.
